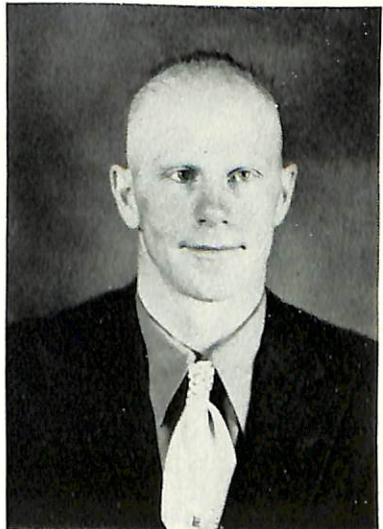

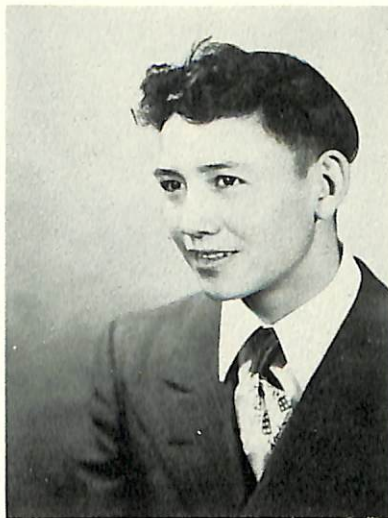

All in all, we're going to hate to leave. There are memories, experiences and events which will influence us the rest of our lives.
